General requirements for all positions as ESR

You must be within your first four years of research experience after completion of your masters degree or equivalent; you cannot hold a doctoral degree at the time of recruitment; you cannot have spent more than 12 months within the past 36 months in the country where the position you are applying for is located (mobility rule); you must be proficient in the English language both written and spoken (proof required).
