

Post. Doc. position at the Department of Inflammation Research

At the Department of Inflammation Research (IIR), which is affiliated with the Department of Spine Surgery, Joint and Connective Tissue Diseases, Rigshospitalet, a position as a scientific employee (37 hours/week) is available for filling as soon as possible. This is a fixed-term contract of 12 months with the possibility of possible extension.

The place of work is IIR's laboratory facilities at Rigshospitalet, section 7541.

About the Department of Inflammation Research:

IIR conducts research into pathogenetic mechanisms behind autoimmune diseases as well as immunomodulatory drugs. The applicant will have a middle management function for a research team dealing with autoimmune responses in general, and the functions of T and B cells in particular. In addition to the laboratory manager, the team consists of 2 laboratory technicians and 3 postdocs and a varying number of PhD and master's students. A primary function for the applicant will be to instruct students and staff in, among other things, flow cytometry and other relevant techniques. In agreement with the laboratory manager, the applicant will have the opportunity to establish a base at IIR, from which his/her own ideas for research within the laboratory's research area can be developed to the extent that he or she can help apply for funding for this.

We expect that you as an applicant have:

- Proven research experience at PhD level.
- Possess competencies in flow cytometry and possibly other immunological techniques, protein chemistry and/or molecular biology.
- Experience in guidance and work management will be an advantage.
